William the Conqueror built this castle in 1086, could there be a more spectacular setting for the race start? Start your day early, explore local food and drink, meet talented producers, and enjoy entertainment and family activities.

Follow the cobbles down Steep Hill to the city centre beyond and you'll find plenty of reasons to linger longer and enjoy the city sights, plus take in more cycling fun in the Activity Zone.

The action in Lincolnshire continues on **September 3rd** with the Boston to Skegness stage where the cyclists will race 111 miles with 873m of ascent through Woodhall Spa, Horncastle and Wragby, the Lincolnshire Wolds, Louth, Mablethorpe and Sutton-on-Sea before a sprint finish into Skegness.
